ENERGY ASSISTANCE

The Senior Center in cooperation with the New Britain Resource Agency, is taking appointments for the state of Connecticut's Energy Assistance Program. Proof of all income from the month prior to applying must be available. This includes all pages of the latest bank statement on a checking or saving account. Copies of oil, gas or electric bills, a rent receipt or a property tax bill are also required. You may have up to \$10,000.00 in assets as a home owner and \$7,000.00 in assets as a renter to qualify. If you were ineligible in the past years, this may be the year to reapply for energy assistance.

Rebuilding Together is the nation's largest volunteer-based provider of home repair services. Our goal is to assist low-income homeowners with repairs and improvements that they are unable to take care of on their own, due to physical and /or financial limitations. These repairs are done by community volunteers, at no cost to selected homeowners.

Typical services range from yard work and general cleaning, to light carpentry, electrical and plumbing repairs, as well as installation of grab bars and other simple modifications designed to allow senior to age safely in place. We are neighbors helping neighbors, one home at a time.
