

## LEGAL NOTICE Decisions of the ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS City of New Britain

The following actions were taken at the Zoning Board of Appeals Regular Meeting of Thursday, September 19, 2013:

**#4648**: Daniel D. Cummings's request for a variance to Section 70-40-70.01, and 230-40-30, in order to allow the construction of a covered front porch to be added to an existing single-family house at 391 Lincoln Street was **GRANTED**.

**#4649**: Brenda Lopez's request for a variance to Section 70-40-70.05, in order to allow the installation of a 15-foot diameter, above-ground swimming pool at 97 Sterling Street was **CONDITIONALLY GRANTED**.

**#4650**: PDS Engineering and Construction's request for a variance to Section 230-100.10 and 185-40-70.01, in order to allow security fencing and a small guard shack at 105 Alton Brooks Way was **CONDITIONALLY GRANTED**.

**#4651**: Hank Ellison and Richard Morgan's request for a variance to Section 250-30 and 250-50, in order to allow new signage for an existing nonconforming gasoline station and convenience store at 168 Farmington Avenue was **CONDITIONALLY GRANTED**.

**#4652 A,B,&C**: Veterans Inc.'s request for variances to Sections 120-40-20, 230-90, and 240-30, in order to renovate a vacant apartment building into 18 units of supportive housing for homeless veterans at 232 Arch Street was **GRANTED**.
