Test yourself for COVID-19 if	Timing
You have any COVID-19 symptoms	Immediately
You were exposed to someone with COVID-19	At least 5 days after your exposure
	If you test negative for COVID-19, consider testing again 1 to 2 days after your first test
You are going to an indoor event or a gathering	Immediately before the gathering, or as close to the time of the event as possible
SOURCE: CDC.GOV	This is especially important before gathering with individuals at risk of severe disease, older adults, those who are immunocompromised, or people who are not up to date on their COVID-19 vaccines, including children who cannot get vaccinated yet
