Bidder declares that the bid is not made in connection with any other Bidder submitting a bid for the same commodity or commodities, and that the bid is bona fide and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. Abstracts of bids received are prepared for distribution by the Department of Purchases.
- 9. Award will be made to the lowest responsible qualified Bidder, who shall be determined in accordance with and pursuant to Section 2-578, inclusive of the Purchasing Ordinances City of New Britain. The quality of the articles to be supplied, their conformity with the specifications, their suitability to the requirements of the City, and the delivery terms will be taken into consideration in making the award.
- 10. Section 2-578, item 10, allows up to a ten (10) percent differential in favor of resident Bidders for all purchases and contracts except construction and/or capital improvements.
