- 4. The time of proposed delivery must be stated in definite terms. If time of delivery for different commodities varies, the Bidder shall so state.
- 5. Samples, when requested, must be furnished free of expense to the City, and if not destroyed, will, upon request, be returned at the Bidder's risk and expense.
- 6. Price Quotations must be stated in units of quantity specified, show unit pricing, include packing and delivery to destination and all other incidental charges included in the grand total price or bid may be rejected. In case of error in the extension of prices, the unit price shall govern.
- 7. Unless qualified by the provision "NO SUBSTITUTE", the use of the name of a manufacturer, brand, make or catalog designation in specifying an item does not restrict Bidders to the manufacturer, brand, make or catalog designation identification. This is used simply to indicate the character, quality and/or performance equivalence of the commodity desired, but the commodity on which bids are submitted must be of such character, quality and/or performance equivalence that it will serve the purpose for which it is to be used equally as well as that specified. The City reserves the right to make final determination of equivalency.

Consideration will be given to bids submitted on alternate commodities to the extent that such action is deemed to serve best the interests of the City. If the Bidder does not indicate that the commodity he proposed to furnish is other than specified, it will be construed to mean that the Bidder proposes to furnish the exact commodity described.

- 8. Bidder declares that the bid is not made in connection with any other Bidder submitting a bid for the same commodity or commodities, and that the bid is bona fide and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. Abstracts of bids received are prepared for distribution by the Department of Purchases.
- 9. Award will be made to the lowest responsible qualified Bidder, who shall be determined in accordance with and pursuant to Section 2-578, inclusive of the Purchasing Ordinances City of New Britain. The quality of the articles to be supplied, their conformity with the specifications, their suitability to the requirements of the City, and the delivery terms will be taken into consideration in making the award.
- 10. Section 2-578, item 10, allows up to a ten (10) percent differential in favor of resident Bidders for all purchases and contracts except construction and/or capital improvements. Any city-based bidder, which has submitted a bid, shall be awarded the bid provided that such city-based bidder agrees to accept the award of the bid at the amount of the low bid. In a situation where no city-based bidder submits a bid or where a city-based bidder does not come within the ten (10) percent or chooses not to meet the lowest bid however, there are bids submitted by companies based in Connecticut and other companies based outside Connecticut, in that event the Purchasing Agent shall allow a five (5) per cent differential in favor of the Connecticut based bidder. Each bid is received with the understanding that the acceptance in writing by the City of the offer to furnish any or all of the commodities and/or services described therein shall constitute a contract between the Bidder and the City, which shall bind the Bidder on his part to furnish and deliver the articles quoted at the prices stated and in accordance with the conditions of said accepted bid.

- 15. Any equipment delivered must be standard new equipment, latest model, except as otherwise specifically stated in bid. MUELLER A423 SUPER CENTUREON 250 DRY BARREL FIRE HYDRANT SPECIFICATION CONFORMING TO AWWA C502

The City of New Britain is soliciting bids for 50 Mueller A423 super centurion 250 dry barrel fire hydrants with bases per the following specifications. No Substitutions will be allowed. The number of hydrants purchased under this bid may not be 50. The City reserves the right to order less than or more than 50. Hydrants will be ordered on an "as-needed" basis.

- Hydrants shall be designed, manufactured, and tested in compliance with the latest revision of AWWA C-502 "STANDARD FOR DRY BARREL HYDRANTS" as published by the American Waterworks Association.
- 2. Hydrants shall be "Traffic" type, with a replaceable "breakable" unit immediately above the ground line for minimizing repairs due to traffic damage. Depth of bury shall be 5 1/2 feet.
- Hydrants shall be of the compression type, constructed such that the main valve closes with the water pressure to assure no loss of water in the event of damage to the upper portion of the hydrant.
- 4. The main valve shall have a minimum diameter of 5 1/4", to assure optimum flow.
- 5. Hydrant shall be of the dry top design with "O" ring seals to insure that the operating threads will be protected from water entry. Dry top design is to include a factory lubricated operating mechanism, which allows supplemental lubricant to be added in the field without removal of the top section. Standard lubricant shall be oil, suitable for a temperature range of -60 to +150 degrees Fahrenheit, and shall incorporate a system of forced lubrication of the thrust collar area each time the hydrant is operated.
- 6. The operating nut shall be a one-piece bronze casting. Both the operating nut and nozzle cap nuts are to be pentagon in shape and measure 1 1/2 inches from point to flat at the base of the nut and the overall height of the nut shall not be less than 1". Caps are to be provided with rubber gaskets and non-kinking type chains.
- 7. Hydrants shall have two-2 1/2" NST hose nozzles, and one- 4 1/2" NST pumper nozzle. The threads are to be "National Standard Threads". (NST)
- 8. The hydrant nozzle section shall be capable of rotation through 360 degrees with respect to the standpipe.
- 9. The minimum distance allowable between the centerline of the lowest nozzle and the ground line shall be 18".
- 10. Each hydrant shall have permanent markings cast into the upper barrel assembly, identifying the manufacturer, name and size of main valve opening and year of manufacture.

- 11. Each hydrant shall have an identification mark indicating direction of opening and shall be "OPEN LEFT".
- 12. Hydrants shall have an automatic drain that is operated by the main valve rod. Drain valve is to open as the main valve is closed and close and the main valve is opened. The port and seat of the main valve shall be bronze.
- 13. The outside of the hydrants top section shall be painted a minimum of one coat of primer and one finished coat of enamel. The upper barrel shall be painted red with the bonnet and cap painted silver. Paint shall be factory applied to New Britain Public Works Department, Utilities Division's Specifications.
- 14. The shoe of the hydrant shall be provided with a MJ type of inlet, 6" in size, D150 type. The internal surfaces of the shoe, the lower valve plate, and cap nut, shall be coated with a factory applied two part, thermosetting epoxy coating with a minimum thickness of 4 mills. The shoe must include an American made mega lug type gland with bolts and rubber gaskets.
- 15. The bronze valve seat shall be threaded into a bronze drain ring or shoe bushing to prevent electrolysis between these components. The drain channel shall be all bronze.
- 16. The hydrant shall have two drain outlets above the lower flange of the hydrant shoe assembly.
- 17. Hydrants shall be designed to permit the use of extension sections and allow all parts to be removable from ground level without requiring excavation of the hydrant.
- 18. All hydrants furnished under the terms of these specifications must be accompanied by a certification, signed by an officer of the manufacturing company, that the furnished hydrants meet all aspects and standards contained within these specifications.
- 19. All hydrants must have a standard test pressure of 250 PSIG working water pressure and 400 PSIG test pressure, and be certified as such by the manufacturer.
- 20. All hydrants furnished shall have a standard 10-year warranty certified by the manufacturer.

NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS CERTIFICATION REQUIRED

The City of New Britain Code of Ordinances, Sec. 2-575, reads as follows:

Sec. 2-575. Rejection of bid where bidder is in default to city. The agent shall not accept the bid of a contractor who is in default on the payment of taxes, licenses or other monies due the city.

The agent shall include in the bid document a form to be executed by a bidder, certifying that said bidder is not in default on the payment of taxes, licenses or other monies due the city. As used in this section, (1) a "principal" of a contractor shall mean an individual who is a director, an officer, an owner, a limited partner or a general partner; and (2) "default in the payment of taxes" shall mean the failure to pay taxes by the date such taxes are due and payable or the failure to be current with respect to a delinquent taxes payment schedule as set forth in a written agreement with the Tax Collector.

In accordance with this provision, prospective vendors make the following certification:

General Instructions

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form
