Smart City Goals 2020/2021

- 5% reduction in energy focus on demand reduction (schools closed due to Covid will contribute to this)
- LED light retrofit projects at schools completion
- Expand fiber network to increase connectivity to City Hall

What are our potential 2022 SMART goals?

- Fund NB FLUSH investment into sewer infrastructure that includes massive line replacements
- Continue to utilize the Blight Task Force to revitalize run down properties
- Look into viability of City composting program
- Find possible energy improvements that can be made
- Add more electric vehicles to our fleet
- Continue to expand fiber connectivity
- Continue to improve our IT software in different departments:
 - Parks and Recreation
 - Golf
 - Cemetery
- Explore the possibilities of a data center within City Hall
- Finish installing LED lights in all City owned buildings. Most already have it and should be finished in a few months
- Look into purchasing street lights from Eversource in order to saving maintenance costs over time
- Explore possibility of solar canopies over parking spots and the new fuel cell project
- Establish guidelines for all new building projects concerning sustainable energy
- Develop long term energy plan
